

## **Summary of 3.PRV-PatCom Meeting at Stockholm on September 27, 2011** **Agreed Version**

### **1. Introduction and Agenda**

*Johan Winther* welcomes the PatCom delegation and *Willem Lagemaat* thanked for the possibility of the meeting. The agenda has been approved.

### **2. Approval of the Summary of the 2010 Meeting**

The agreed summary has been approved and will be mailed to PRV.

### **3. External Assistance for PRV Open Records**

*Anders Bruun* explained that a concrete proposal is necessary that especially the legal department can decide about the feasibility. In principle there exist two areas where assistance may help:

- 1) Full text transfer into a format for and accepted by EPO. It is clear that also providers in case of assistance need some benefit. PRV should be free for data usage, but there should be an agreed incentive (e.g. fee sharing) in case of data transfer to another commercial provider.
- 2) OCR-ing of bibliodata from the Swedish gazette. The volume is about 10.000 to 15.000 records/year about for 6 years.  
The cooperation shall be organized either via tender and/or by contract although the value is symbolic here; full text is more. PRV can then concentrate on actual work but shall keep authorisation for distribution of the data.

*Willem Lagemaat* mentions the possibility of bundling full text work with bibliodata OCR.

*Johan Winther* has now a better picture and can check possibilities with PRV management.

The Swedish-English dictionary for MT is for sale although the price is not yet fixed. Here the EPO-Google cooperation has been shortly discussed.

### **5. Development in Electronic Publication and Legal Status Update**

*Asa Viken* gave a demonstration of the new Swedish patent database and asked PatCom members to have a look on it and to give feedback if there are further proposals. PRV introduced a new code T6 for "Limited Patent". The gazette publication is only in Swedish but notification information is in English, too. PRV is working on a limited specification.

The possible effects of the unitary patent development have been discussed. PRV as well as PatCom see still open points in jurisdiction and finances and in principle political issues.

*Anders Bruuns* mentioned that the German classification DPK is available at PRV in English, German and Swedish.

## **6. Licensing of PRV Material – Full Text Delivery**

*Asa Viken* explained that raw data delivery has not yet started and is planned in St.36 and XML. A service for trademarks exists.

*Willem Lagemaat* asked for the back file and a front file weekly update. He expects that the pricing will be at marginal costs. PRV sees this 2012 in its pricing list. He explained the interaction in the market and the necessity of weekly update of the legal status. In a short discussion on pricing policies and the PRV schedule, PRV declared that the information will be given as soon as available.

Protection against robots in the download segment exists internally. PRV has encrypted URL's.
