Pursuing a global coverage



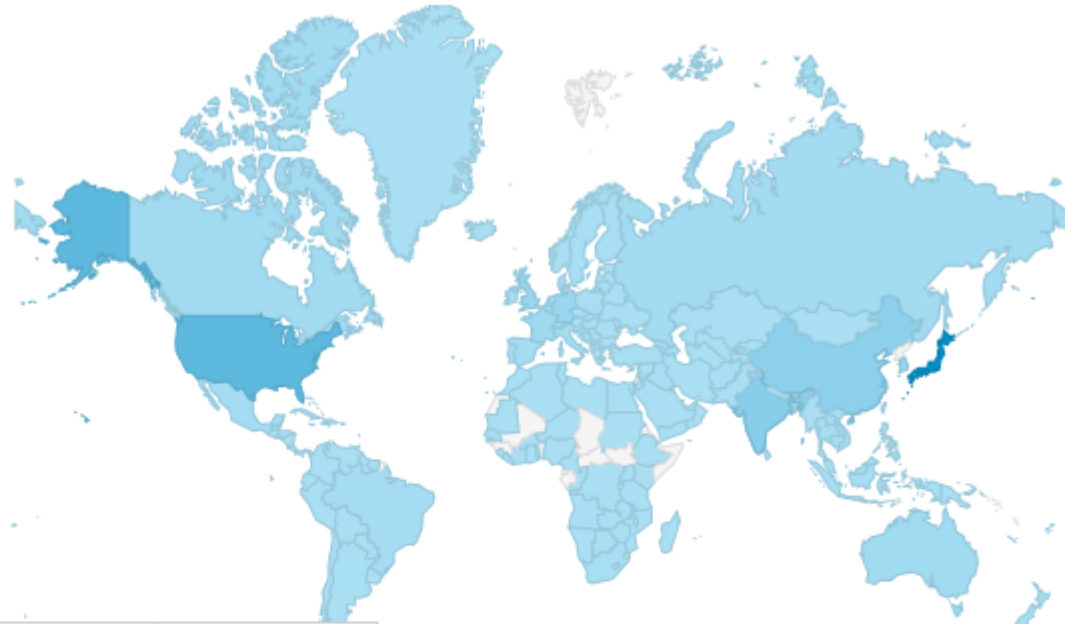
Today's situation:

- **39 national/regional collections including big offices like:
PCT, China, EPO, Japan, Korea, Russia, US,
Canada ...**
- **35 million biblio records, 25 million full text records**
- **Australia, UK, Germany**

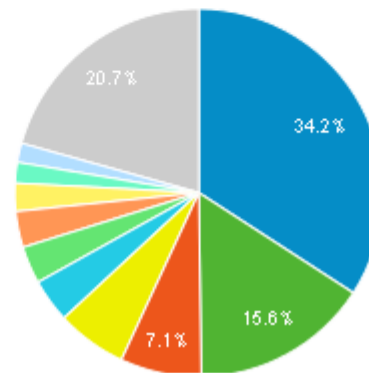
Statistics

- **35k** unique visitors per day, 300 concurrent users, 150k queries per day
- **250k** unique visitors per month
- Good usage of WO applications and complex queries
- Important number of crawlers

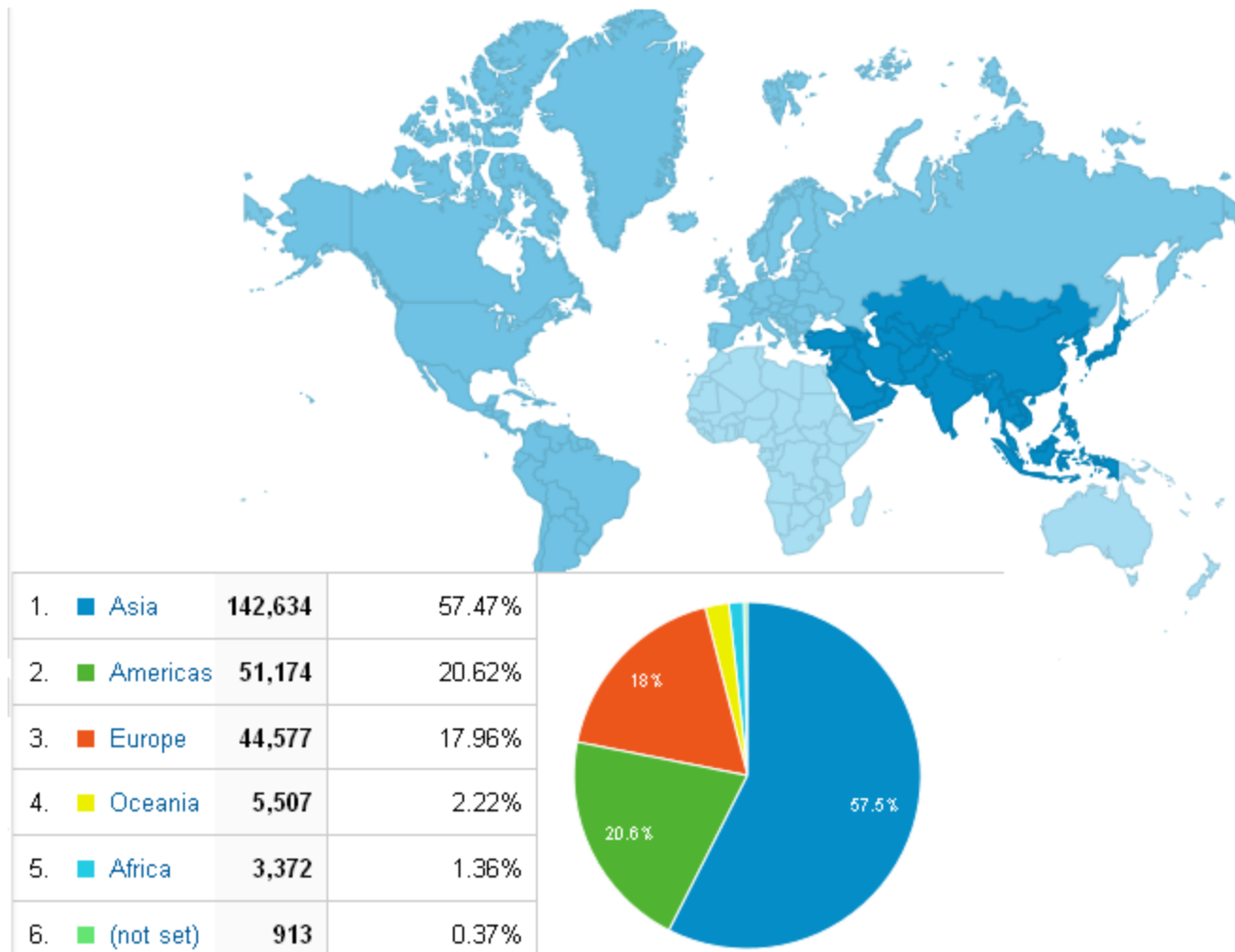
Statistics – Visits – Country View
